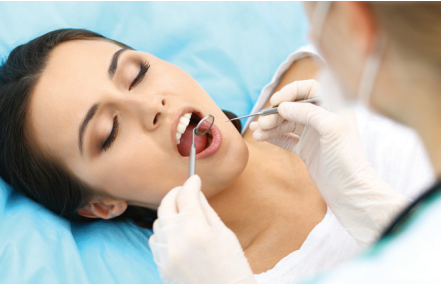

INCREASE YOUR PATIENT BASE: Did you know that 30 percent of the U.S. population—or 94 million people—avoid the dentist due to fear? Oral sedation dentistry solves the problem of fear and opens up your practice to an entirely new subset of patients.

COMPLETE MORE DENTISTRY IN LESS TIME: Patients who request sedation dentistry usually require more procedures due to having put off treatment for so long. Because these patients are in the same chair for an extended period of time, the number of room setups per procedure are vastly reduced, increasing doctor and team efficiency and lowering overhead cost.

KEEP MORE PATIENTS IN-HOUSE: Sedation allows you to complete more extensive work in a single appointment, often simplifying treatment planning and improving case acceptance.

SCHEDULE INTEGRITY: Missed appointments are nearly eliminated because patients prepay for their visits. There is more incentive for them to follow through. Thus, sedation dentistry virtually makes cancelled appointments a thing of the past: On average, only 1 out of every 500 sedation appointments is cancelled.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT: This benefit is the single most impactful result of implementing sedation: the simple gratitude patients express as a result of finally receiving comfortable treatment they have so long put off.

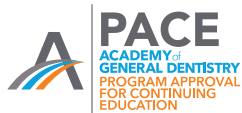
